If you have a previous version, version 1.1, please refer to the manual for some suggestions on updating so that you retain your data.

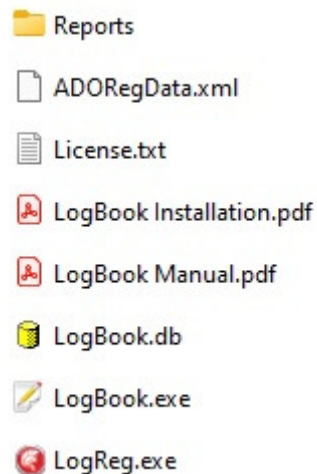
Installation

To keep everything simple the default installation has all the files in one directory with a sub directory for Reports. The software should operate like this in any directory you choose to install it on your computer. Simply copy the files into your chosen directory and run the program LogBook.exe

For various reasons it may be best to store the database file in its own directory and in that case we need to set a path for the database file. Another reason for setting the path is if the program cannot locate the database file for some reason in the default install.

A utility program is provided for setting the path if required.

Installation Files



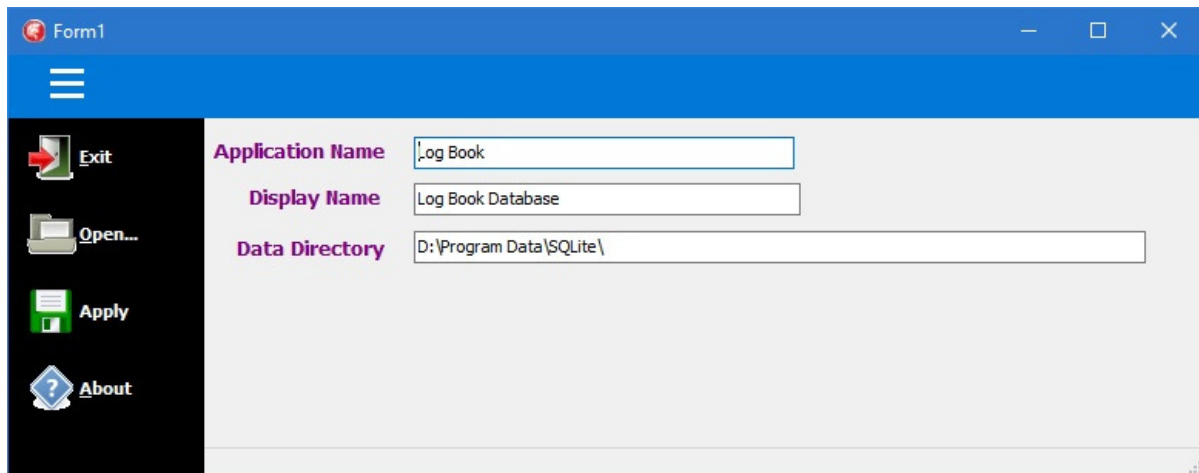
If you have a previous version you may notice there are two files that are no longer needed in this updated version. LogBook.exe is the actual program and LogBook.db your Data File..

To Set the Database Path

The program uses an SQLite Database. The file name is LogBook.db which will contain your data and should be regularly backed up.

If you move LogBook.db to another directory then run the utility LogReg.exe to set the path. The path you set is stored in the file ADORegData.xml which must remain in the same directory as the main program (LogBook.exe)

Application Name

You cannot change this but if “Log Book” is not showing then the file ADORegData.xml is either missing or corrupt—in which case reinstate the file.

Display Name

You may change this to include any text you would like to be displayed on the top bar of the application screen

Data Directory

By default this is left blank and the Database file will be located in the same directory as the application.

In the example above the Database file LogBook.db has been located in the directory D:\Program Data\SQLite

Save any changes you have made by pressing the “Apply” button on the left panel
